Ref. Atopos 2007.08.038 SUBJECT Shoes: traditional Japanese style. Shoes made of two different pieces: Upper part (Body of the shoe) and DESCRIPTION Lower part (Soil); tighten together (cf. infra). **CREATOR** Unknown NATURE Unwoven material (Body) and woven material (Soil). Date of production 19th Century? Notes The big toe is separated from the other toes (cf. Infra), it permit to tighten the soil to the body of the shoe. Upper part: paper designed as felt; this material is bend and formed in the PRIMARY SUPPORT shape of a foot. Lower part: ropes made of gross natural fibres; those ropes are woven together in order to build up the soil. MEDIA Upper part material is printed with patterns; flower shape patterns appears on printed blackish background. MOUNTING The body (Upper part) is made of several pieces of unwoven material sewed together. Soil (Lower part) is knotting work like. Extra length of ropes tighten the soil to the upper part of the shoe through the gap between big and other toes (cf. infra). Fairly good condition: Deformation of the upper part (body); Superficial GENERAL CONDITION dirtiness due to the storage. Collapsing like deformation of the upper part of the shoe; Few wears of the **PHYSICAL** lower part. DEGRADATION PHYSIOCHEMICAL Fairly good condition of the upper and lower parts. No discolouration or loss

are noticed.

Conservation Report (English abstract):

TREATMENTS	Surface cleaning of the two parts with soft brush. Upper part is reshaped with help of moisture: Material is left 1 hours long in a moisture cell; The unwoven material is softened; The inner space of the body is stuffed with paper filling and left to dry; This operation is renewed till good result. The wears in the lower part are mended with paste.	
PRODUCTS	Soft brush, conservation vacuum cleaner; Pure wheat starch paste.
